Dearborn Fire Department to Train Using Bullex Smart Class A System

Albany, NY, 6/28/16 – Dearborn Fire Department in Michigan has commissioned Bullex to design and build a Smart Class A fire training system.

Bullex's signature Smart Class A system allows firefighter to train using real smoke, heat and flames in a controlled and repeatable environment. The system allows instructors to stop and start the evolution at any time so that every trainee can learn the desired skill.

Bullex will house the Smart Class A system inside two training containers. The structure will also feature movable walls to vary the training scenarios and a walkable roof to allow for ventilation training. Also included is a SCADA system for data logging and monitoring fire behavior changes.

The training containers are set to be delivered to Dearborn Fire in the fall of 2016. In addition to the Smart Class A system, Dearborn Fire has also acquired Bullex's Vehicle Fire and Dumpster Fire Training Systems.
